About Tolima

The department of Tolima is located between the areas of the dry valley of the Magdalena River, which is a territory recognized by its geographic wealth and climatic diversity. It hosts landscapes filled with broad plains, unrivaled valleys and mountain ranges, as well as white, snow-capped mountains.

In geographic terms, it is located on the central mountain range, exactly in the midwestern part of the country, and borders the departments of Caldas, Cundinamarca, Huila, Cauca, Valle del Cauca, Quindío and Risaralda. Tolima has unparalleled agricultural wealth, known for its rice, cotton and coffee and their excellent quality. Tolima has great water sources due to its proximity to the Magdalena river, which crosses through the entire department.



Gaitania

This village is located in the Planadas municipality in the department of Tolima and is surrounded by high mountains covered with extensive forests and coffee plantations. A large part of the Nevado del Huila volcano is located inside this geographic area, which is one of the purest, largest and most important water sources in Colombia because of its ice cap.




