Lengupá is a province located in the center of Colombia, in the southern part of the department of Boyacá. It has an area of more than 1,500 square kilometers and is made up of six municipalities: Berbeo, Campohermoso, Zetaquirá, Páez, San Eduardo and Miraflores, its capital.


It exhibits a great variety of climates, from temperate in the foothills of the plains, to temperatures below freezing on the Vijagual moorland, making the province a natural paradise rich in biodiversity, with waterfalls, lagoons and virgin forest reserves. It is also abundant in crops such as honey and sugar cane, yuca, maize and plantain, amongst others.


